


Emo Court & Gardens

WITH PARKLANDS OPEN 365 DAYS A YEAR, THIS FESTIVE SEASON IS THE PERFECT TIME TO TAKE A WINTER WALK AT EMO. ENJOY THE MILE-LONG WELLINGTONIA AVENUE, FLANKED BY GIANT SEQUOIA TREES PLANTED IN 1853, WANDER AMONG THE ELEGANT YEWS AND STATUARY OF THE FORMAL LAWNS, AND RARE BIRDS INCLUDING BUZZARDS AND EGRETS.







Heywood Gardens

THE EIGHTEENTH-CENTURY ROMANTIC LANDSCAPE CONSISTS OF GARDENS,
LAKES, WOODLAND AND ARCHITECTURAL FEATURES. IT WAS TRANSFERRED TO STATE OWNERSHIP IN NOVEMBER 1993
FROM THE SALESIAN FATHERS WHO HAD TAKEN CARE OF IT SINCE 1941.








Slieve Bloom Mountains

Morriseys Pub Abbeyleix

DATING FROM 1775 WHEN IT WAS ORIGINALLY A GROCERY STORE. THIS TREASURE OF A PUB HAS WITHSTOOD THE ONSLAUGHT OF MODERNISATION. BULLS EYES AND CLOVE ROCKS IN JARS LINE THE SHELVES ABOVE THE PEW SEATS.







Mountmellick museum

THE MAIN FOCUS OF THE MUSEUM IS TO CONSERVE AND DISPLAY ORIGINAL PIECES OF MOUNTMELLICK WORK (EMBROIDERY) AND TO PROTECT THE MEMORY OF MOUNTMELLICK'S RICH QUAKER INDUSTRIAL PAST.

Donaghmore Workhouse Durrow

THE UNADORNED STONE DONAGHMORE WORKHOUSE, WEST OF DURROW, WAS A LAST RESORT FOR THE DESTITUTE IN THE 1850S - ONE OF 130 WORKHOUSES IN THE COUNTRY AT THE TIME.
